- Other mentor-related duties as assigned

- General Computer Skills and Familiarity with Windows Office and Video Conferencing
- **2-8 hours a week** (one tutoring session is about 50 min)
- *Remote mentors* must have a laptop/desktop with a camera and reliable internet and must be 18+ years old
- *In-person mentors* will be provided a device and must follow the COVID health and safety (masks) policy, and 16 years or older
